SECTION D

TEEN ZONE RULES

1. Everyone must sign into the Teen Zone upon arrival, and sign out when leaving.
2. The hours of the Teen Zone must be respected.
3. Damage or destruction to any property of the Teen Zone either intentionally or through neglect will NOT be tolerated. Please report any damage that was done unintentionally and there will be no penalty for that. The MP's will be contacted for any vandalism. Items that have been deliberately broken will be paid for, at replacement cost, by the participant and guardians.
4. Running/loitering in the WMFRC hallways is not permitted.
5. The WMFRC enforces a strict HANDS OFF policy and monitors the use of appropriate language and behaviour.
6. Disregarding instructions from staff or supervisors will not be acceptable. Unauthorized disorderly or disruptive behaviour is prohibited. Including the use of obscene or insulting languages/gestures, yelling, boisterous behaviour, throwing objects and littering.
7. Spills and/or messes must be cleaned up by the person(s) who made them, but do not be afraid to ask for help. Accidents happen.
8. The Teen Zone is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Leave important and/or valuable items safe at home!
9. All participants and staff are to be treated in a positive and respectful manner. Teen Zone has zero tolerance for any form of bullying, neglect, racism, harassment, humiliation, substance abuse or disrespectful behaviour toward others.
10. There is zero tolerance for the possession, selling and/or use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or any other harmful or illegal substance. There will be no smoking in or around the Centre or within 100m of the building.
11. Dangerous or harmful objects are prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to guns, knives, razors, air soft guns, etc. Individuals found in violation of this policy will be banned. In most cases, guardians and the MP's will be notified.
